Two weeks to prepare you to facilitate FLO - Fundamentals and the FLO family of courses

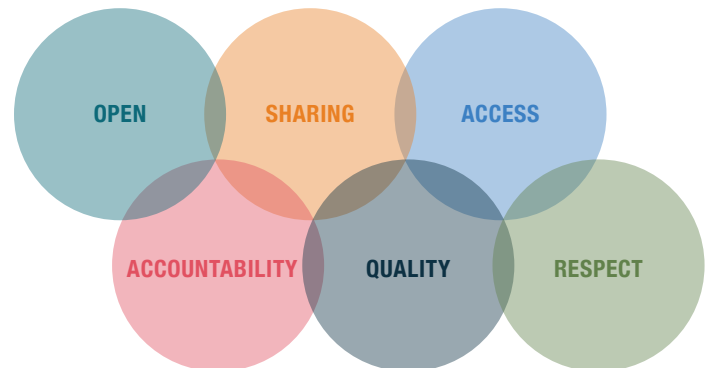
#### [Facilitating Learning Online \(FLO\) - Synchronous](#)
