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## Training and Resources Jurisdictional Scan Summary

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A general website scan of training and resources was undertaken to get a better sense of the number and types of training and resources that currently exist, relating to sexual violence and misconduct.

Over 155 items are included in the list of training and resources, which has been grouped into three broad sections:

- BC Post Secondary (offered by institutions or student groups)
- BC Organizations and Government
- Other Organizations – Outside of BC

Within these sections, items are organized by sub-topics according to the main focus of the training or resource. Overall, it is noted that the topics with the most existing training and resources are:

- Sexual Violence 101 (general information on sexual violence and prevention)
- Consent
- Bystander Intervention
- Disclosure

There appears to be more limited training and resources for topics that are less general in nature and that deal with more focused topics including:

- International students;
- Indigenous students;
- LGBTQ+ students;
- Students with disabilities;
- masculinity vis a vis sexual misconduct
- privilege and power, etc.

The identified training and resources showcase the wide variety of formats and methods that are used to convey information. This includes online or in-person training, along with the use of videos, posters, infographics and guides or handbooks.
