


## Faculty Pivot to Online Teaching

This survey, conducted in June 2020, serves as a snapshot of how B.C. post-secondary educators have responded to the recent emergency to "pivot" courses online due to COVID-19, and how they are planning to proceed into Fall 2020.

made their course more flexible for students to access and complete




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
## Moving Forward (12-18 months)




What technologies do you expect to use in your online courses?
