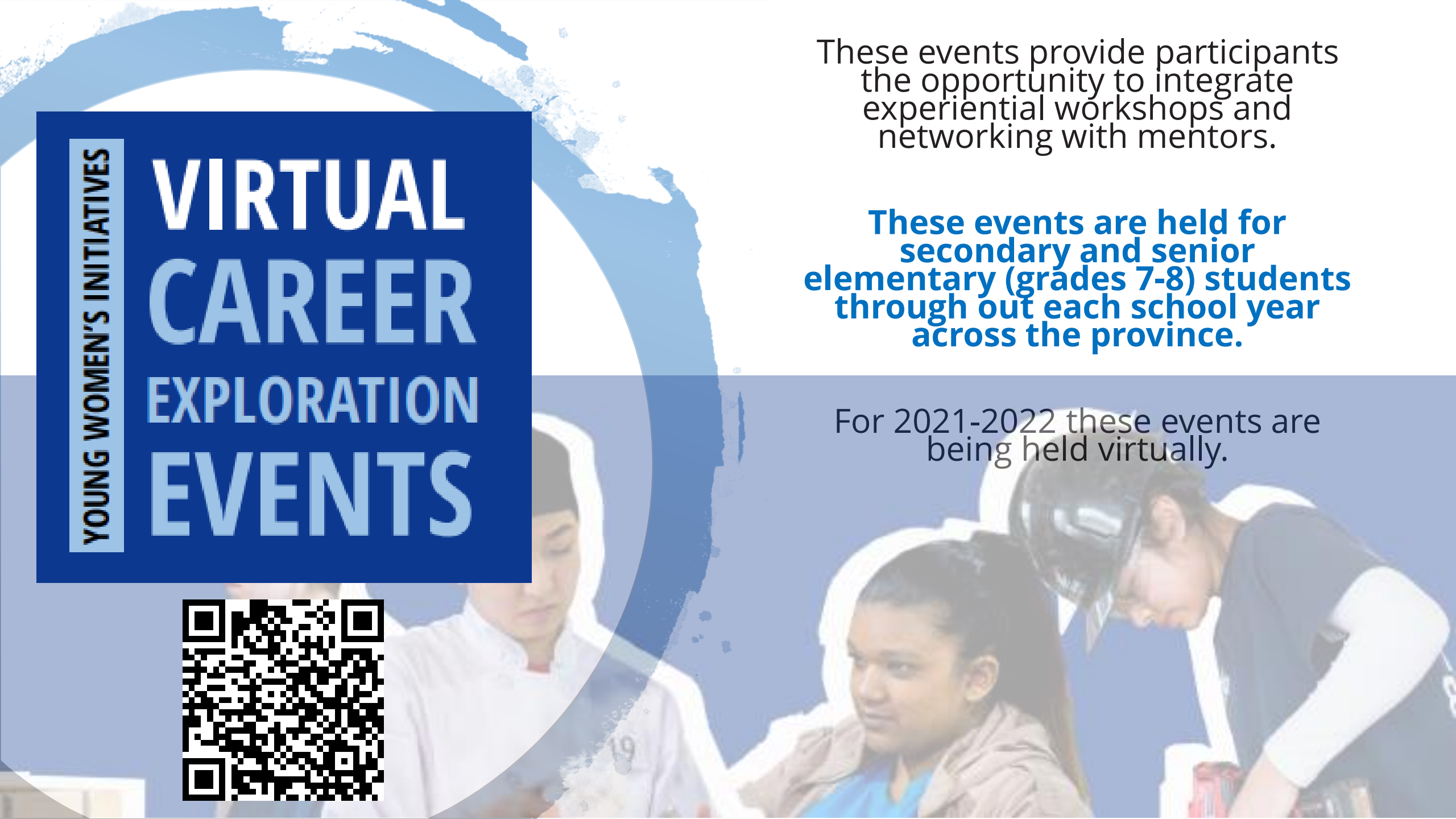
VIRTUAL CAREER EXPLORATION EVENTS

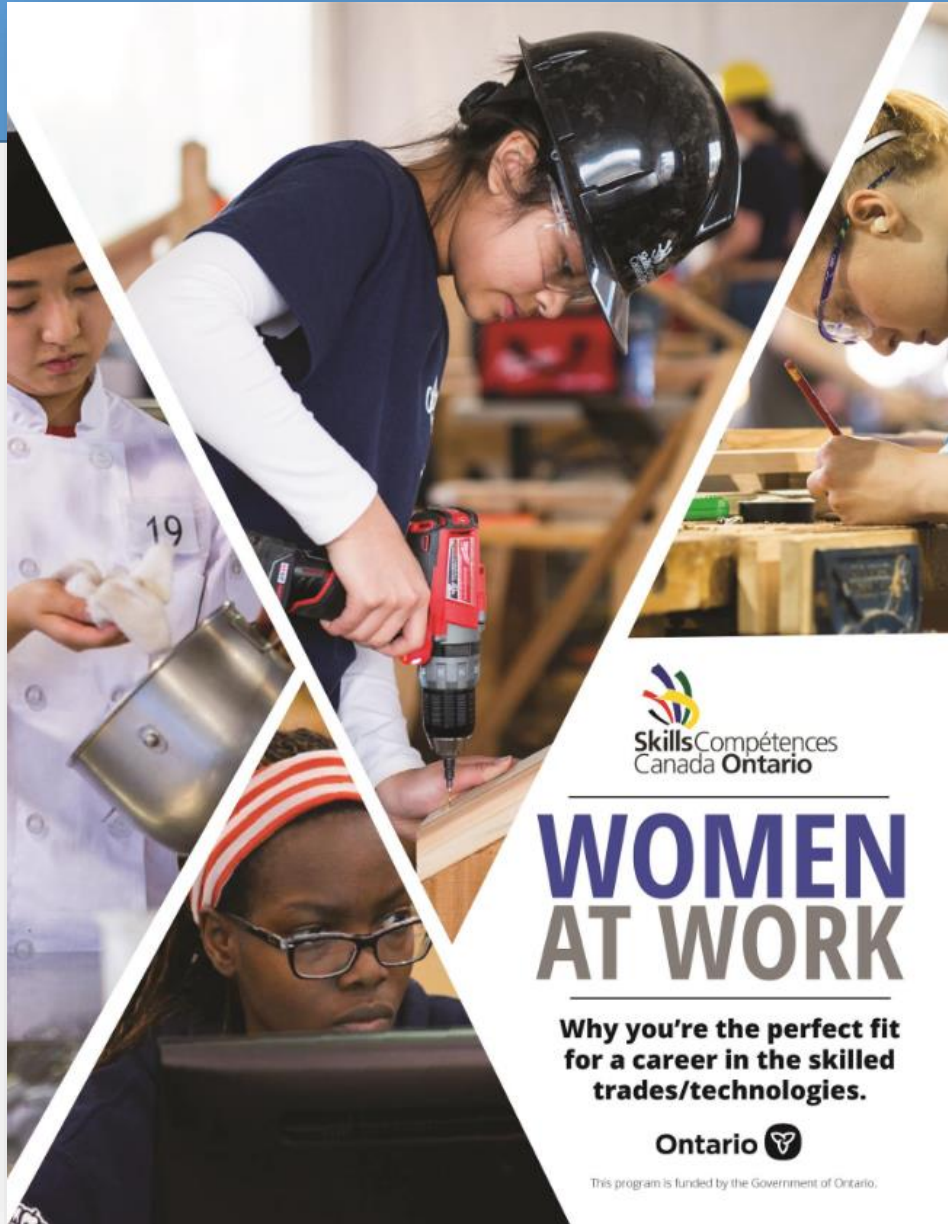

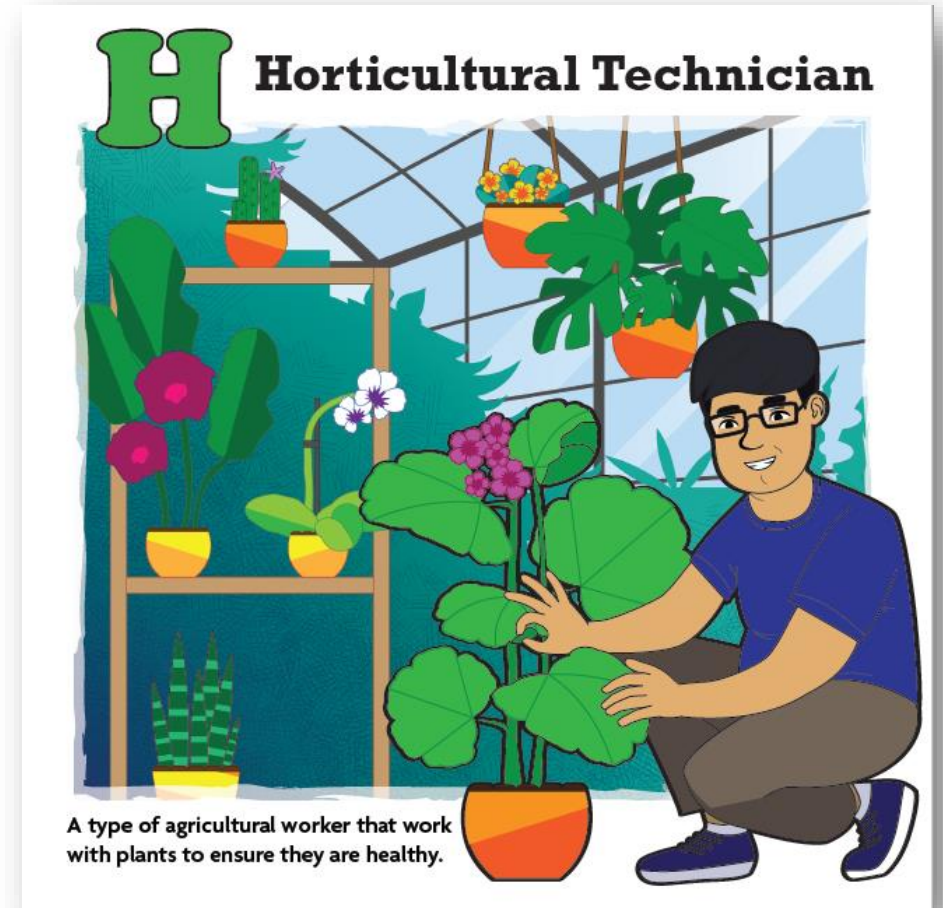

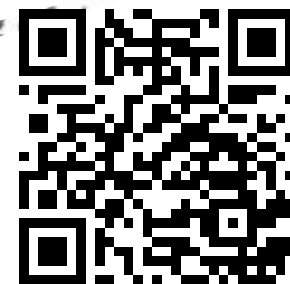
