What is Pressbooks?


- Pressbooks is a digital publishing tool commonly used for open textbooks


Hooks



Crochet hooks are either sold separately or in sets. Seen here is a set of six aluminum crochet hooks, ranging in size from 3.75 mm to 6.5 mm.

Step 1: Calculate the increase in cups served.

[latex]\LARGE201-78=\text{123 more cups of coffee}[/latex]

Step 2: Write down the formula you are going to work with.

[latex]\text{Percentage change}=\dfrac{\text{Actual increase or decrease}}}{\text{Original amount}}\times100[/latex]

Step 3: Plug the numbers into the formula.

[latex]\LARGE\text{Percentage change}=\dfrac{123}{78}\times100[/latex]
