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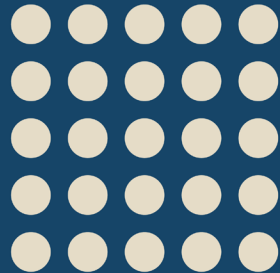

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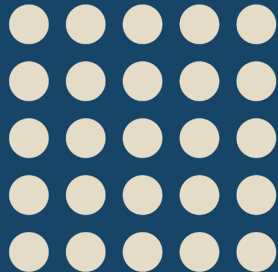
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BCcampus drives innovation in teaching, learning, and open education in alignment with B.C.'s post-secondary system priorities. To fulfill its mandate, BCcampus:

Survey respondents overwhelmingly agreed that AI use will become a normal part of education. About three-quarters thought that AI will make teaching more challenging but 59% agreed that AI will make teaching more efficient. How do you see people's perceptions of AI changing over time?
