More Accessible PDFs

- More accessible pdfs come from accessible source documents
- Word documents:
 - Headings
 - ► Alt-texts for images
 - Descriptive links
- PowerPoint decks:
 - Textboxes
 - ► Text size and type
 - Colour and contrast
 - Slide content order

How to Review a PDF for Accessibility in Adobe

- Adobe Acrobat Pro
 - Need to acknowledge barriers innate to Adobe access in our institutions, cost and training barriers
- Accessibility Check
 - In Tools menu
- Read Out Loud Function
 - ► In View menu

So You Want to Remediate a PDF

- First take a deep breath and be patient
- ▶ Option 1:
 - In Tools Menu, Action Wizard
- ► Option 2:
 - Autotag document (it may not work accurately or completely)
- ► Option 3:
 - ► What I like to call reading order jenga
